CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and information

ENTRY

1. Complete the entry form and mark correct category.
2. An entry form is required for each category
3. You can enter a category more than once so long as you have different varieties in that category.
4. All entries to be grown or home-made by the entrant. Tasmanian residents and growers only.
5. All entries must be received between 9am the day before the festival until 10am the day of the festival
6. All entries can be submitted to the competition tent at the festival site 338 Four springs road, Selbourne

PRESENTATION OF ENTRIES

1. Product to be named (eg. Tomato Sauce), upon receiving entry the product will be labelled accordingly by competition management.
2. The maker/artist must not be identified on or near the item
3. All jars must be sealed with solid lids

HARDNECK-Purple stripe, Turban, Creole, Rocambole, Porcelain

Category A: Best Garlic

SOFTNECK-Silverskin, Artichoke

Category B: Best Garlic

PRESERVE

Category C: Garlic based Sauce and/or oil

Category D: Garlic based preserve (chutney, pickle, jam, relish)

TOMATO

Category E: Best Red tomato large

Category F: Best Red tomato small

Category G: Best Yellow, Orange, White, Green tomato large

Category H: Best Yellow, Orange, White, Green tomato small

Category I: Best Black, Blue, Purple, Brown tomato large

Category J: Best Black, Blue, Purple, Brown tomato small

PRESERVE

Category K: Tomato based Sauce and/or oil

Category L: Tomato based preserve (chutney, pickle, jam, relish)

Category M: Tomato based pasta sauce/passata

Category N: Present your biggest, weirdest, ugliest or anything else you can think of vegetable you have grown
